REGISTRATION - TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Categories

Participants may register under one of the following categories:

Humanised Documentary (Shot, edited, and created normally by the team)

AI-Generated Documentary (Created fully using AI tools)

2. Group Size

Each participating team must consist of 2–7 members.

3. Script/Story Submission

All participants must register with a script or story.

Registrations submitted without a script/story will not be considered.

4. Non-Refundable Fee

The registration fee is non-refundable under any circumstances

5. Shortlisting Criteria

Teams will be shortlisted on the basis of quality and originality of their submitted documentary

6. Documentary Submission

Teams must produce and submit their documentary by 23rd December.

7. Final Selection for Screening

After the documentary submissions on 23rd December, the top 15 teams will be finalized for screening.

8. Winning Documentary Publication

The top three winning documentaries will be uploaded and showcased on our official social media platforms

All participants will receive an e-certificate.

GUIDELINES OF THE DOCUMENTARY

1. Do not harm, target, or disrespect any individual, religion, culture, or community.
2. Sensitive topics must be handled carefully and responsibly.
3. Script, narration, and storyline must be fully original.
4. The content must not be published or shared previously.
5. No copyrighted visuals, audio, or text should be used.
6. Do not include explicit, vulgar, or inappropriate content.
7. Do not reveal private/personal information without consent.
8. Maintain respect toward all cultures, beliefs, and communities.
9. Include a complete end-credits roll acknowledging contributors, tools, and sources.

“THE DOCUMENTARY MUST BE ENTIRELY ORIGINAL AND SHOULD NOT HARM OR TARGET ANY INDIVIDUAL, RELIGION, OR COMMUNITY.”

AI DOCUMENTARY GUIDELINES

1. The documentary should be entirely AI-generated by the participating team.
2. The documentary must not include any human-shot footage or manually created visuals/audio.
3. All elements script, visuals, voiceover, background music, sound effects, and editing must be AI-generated.
4. Teams must explain their AI creation workflow, including:
 - i. Tools used
 - ii. How the script was generated
 - iii. Visual generation process
 - iv. Audio/voiceover creation
 - v. Editing through AI
5. No copying, modifying, or recreating existing videos, movies, stock visuals, or copyrighted content.
AI-generated output must be respectful, safe, and appropriate

“THIS DOCUMENTARY SHOULD BE ENTIRELY AI-GENERATED BY THE PARTICIPATING TEAM, SHOULD NOT INCLUDE ANY HUMAN-SHOT FOOTAGE, AND SHOULD NOT INTEND TO HARM ANY INDIVIDUAL, RELIGION, OR COMMUNITY.”

VIDEO SPECIFICATIONS

- Resolution: Minimum HD (1080p)
- Duration: 5–7 minutes
- Format: YouTube layout (16:9 aspect ratio)
- Audio: Must be enhanced and of superior quality

SUBMISSION GUIDELINE

Submission Method

- All documentaries must be submitted through the official link provided by the organizers.
- Each team must upload:
 - Final Documentary Video
 - Script File (PDF)
 - Credits List (must include names of sponsors of event provided by organisers)
